1. All abstracts will be peer reviewed by a scientific committee appointed by the conference secretariat

Tourist Attractions :

In addition to the scientific and learning events associated with the HISICON 2018 Conference, the following are some of the most popular tourist attractions within and around the city of Hyderabad.

Within the city :

- **Charminar** : Four minarets as the name suggests was constructed in 1591, a heritage site and a global icon of Hyderabad city. It is surrounded by a variety of markets, located in the centre of the old city
- **Golkonda Fort** : One of the oldest citadel and forts in South India and was the capital of the sultanate of the Qutb Shahi dynasty. It is located 11 -12 kms from Hyderabad, easily approached by road . The light and sound show here depicts the past .
- **The Qutb Shahi Tombs** : located at Ibrahim Bagh close to the Golkonda Fort , a collection of tombs built during the Qutb Shahi dynasty
- **Ramoji Film City** : One of the most popular attractions of modern day visit to Hyderabad. One of the largest studio complexes in the world with 2000 acres of land. This was established by Ramoji Rao in 1996
- **Birla Mandir** : A Hindu temple made of marble constructed by the Birla Foundation on a 85 mts hillock called Naubath Pahad
- **The Buddha Statue** : located in the middle of Hussain Sagar lake, the world's tallest monolith of Gautam Buddha. Can be reached by boating on the lake. This is coupled with the Lumbini Park that also has a popular light and sound fountain show
- **Shilparamam** : an arts and crafts village located in Madhapur Hyderabad, built on 65 acres of land. The main aim of the village is to preserve traditional crafts with ethnic festivals around the year
- **Chilkur Balaji Temple** : A popular temple dedicated to Lord Balaji located at the outskirts of Hyderabad.
- **The Statue of Unity (Ramanujam)** : A popular destination at a short distance from Hyderabad city that depicts the various facets of Vaishnavite culture and forms of the lord
